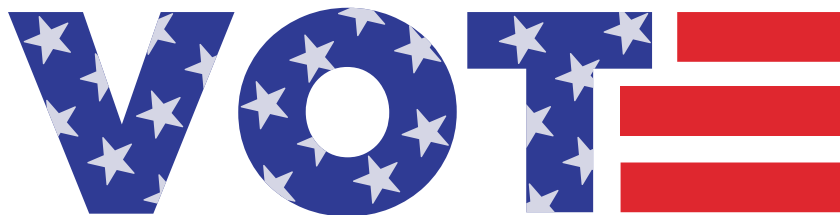

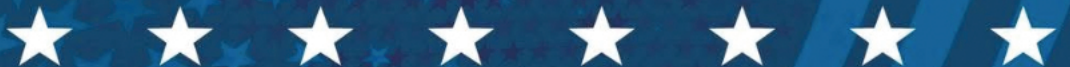

### BALLOT RETURN DEADLINE

**7:00pm, Tuesday, March 17, 2026**

Vote By Mail ballots must be properly postmarked by  
March 17 or returned via Secure Drop Box by 7:00pm.  
Voters are encouraged to return their VBM ballot back  
as soon as they can. In Illinois, election authorities  
will continue to count properly postmarked ballots  
through March 31.
